A Tribute to Mother India BANDE MATARAM by UDAYAN



August 15th 1947 marked the end of the British Raj and is a landmark in the history of modern India. The first half of the programme is comprised of inspiring, soul captivating Bengali patriotic songs which stirred the nation heralding the new, independent India. In a broader perspective, these songs transcend all national barriers to symbolise the eternal quest for freedom from bondage, fear and oppression. A visual projection of English translations of the songs will accompany the live performance.
